agricultural valley that begins at the foot of the Andes and extends west to the Pacific Ocean.



The approximately 910,000 hectares (2,250 acres) in between offer many different microclimates, soil types, steep hillsides ideal for vineyards, and a growing number of wineries that are perfectly able to make excellent Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, and many good Carmenère and Malbec wines.

Here we will find one of the finest boutique hotels in the country: Casa Lapostolle, belonging to the vineyard of the same name.

Casa Lapostolle, the family-owned producer of premium Chilean wine, celebrated the opening of its striking state-of-the-



art gravity-fed **Winery & Lapostolle Residence**, dedicated solely to the production of its flagship wine Clos Apalta.
